### RULE IN REVIEW

This week I want to focus on a rule which is rarely picked up by umpires but happens quite often during a game.

### Page 61. 12.2.1 Moving into Player's Space

- 1. (I) Landing in a place already occupied by an opponent before the movement began
- 2. (ii) Moving into the path of an opponent who is committed to a particular landing space.

Interpretation of the above rule is something that many umpires get wrong simply because they either don't understand the rule itself or they failed to watch the positioning of the defender prior to the previous movement.

The most common example of point (i) is in the shooting circle where the shooters split to gain space whilst feeding the ball out to the wing / centre. Please be mindful here, if the defender has taken up a position PRIOR to the movement (which is usually the 2nd movement) and comes into contact with the defender then technically the shooter has contacted.

TIP: Umpires should always have their rule book handy. Read up on the more complex rules, learn them, learn the page number & where possible the rule number itself. This knowledge is powerful when confronted with captains for clarification & or other umpires.
