Round 12 saw the last of our developing umpires on her very first competition game. Well done Gaelle Creusot, you listened, improved & smiled the entire game, what a lovely umpire you will be.

Congratulations to Anastasia Grubisic who completed her required 4 competition games to receive her White Award. Well done Anastasia, it is hard to believe that you have only umpired 4 games, your terminology & calls are great, you picked up on some infringements which typically we don't see until umpires reach their district Green level. Obstruction without the ball, contact away from the play - these calls show that you are looking ahead and not just at the players who have the ball at the time.

To all of our other developing umpires & mentors thank you for continuing to listen, learn & grow. Each game you will become more confident and this is definitely evident in the changes that we see each week. Practice blowing the whistle at home using your hand signals and the correct terminology. Keep the calls short & simple eg. Blow Whistle, Use Hand Signals, Infringement = Stepping, Penalty = Free Pass, show direction of play and state the team name = Oakhill



Coming into Semi's the sidelines will become more vocal, if any umpire has any challenges please call myself or any other committee member for assistance. If you cannot reach one of us then please send someone up to the admin block or umpires control and ask for assistance. We have a zero tolerance for anyone abusing an umpire. Umpires get it wrong from time to time and at the end of the day it is just a game.

Stay calm everyone as we head into Semi's and good luck.
