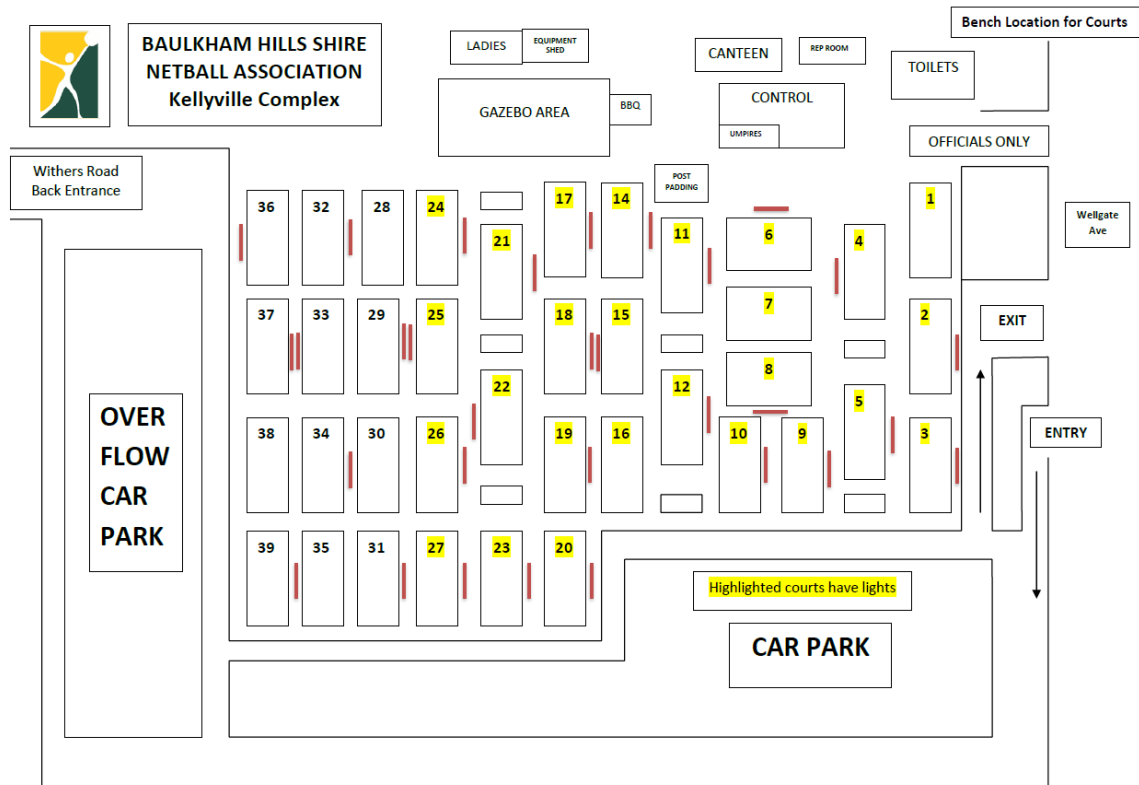

Guidelines for Finals –

- Enjoy the game!
- There are 2 sidelines: On one sideline we have the **Officials Bench**, there should be the coaches, scorer, time keeper, and first aid/carer. **This is shown on the below court map with the red line indicating the Officials Bench.** All spectators need to be on the opposite sideline to the Officials bench, any spectators standing at the Officials Bench or at the ends of the court will be asked to move.
- Cheer loudly and show respect to both teams.
- You cannot borrow players unless our Registrar and BHSNA have been notified in advance and it has been approved.
- Be supportive of the umpires. Umpiring during finals is a tough job, with a multitude of parents analysing your every call. Umpires are only human, mistakes may be made but remember every umpire is doing their best.

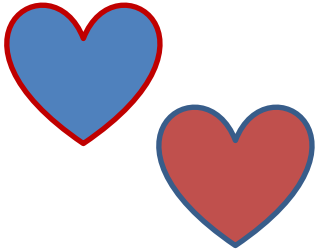
All round awesome defending, shooting & mid-court chasing ladies, see you all in the Grand Finals.
