## Umpiring Report

### 13. GAME MANAGEMENT



The umpires apply the Rules of the Game fairly, communicate clearly and maintain a calm, decisive control.

A player who infringes any part of the foul play rule [Rule 13.2] will be disciplined. Players on the court are expected to respond to rulings by the umpires and adjust their play accordingly.

Similar requirements apply to team officials and bench players.

#### 13.1 ACTIONS THAT MAY BE TAKEN BY UMPIRES

- (i) To manage a match the umpires may, in addition to the normal sanction, use any of the following:
  - (a) Caution a player: a player is advised that the behaviour specified must change
  - (b) Issue a warning to a player: a player is warned that suspension will follow if the behaviour specified continues
  - (c) Suspend a player: a player who is suspended takes no part in play for 2 minutes
  - (d) Order a player off: a player who is ordered off takes no further part in the match.

A long and warm day for our team in white this week. All games were covered and signed on, good effort ladies especially when running between games. Remember whilst umpiring our own teams it is important to still maintain the protocol when approached by players. It needs to be in a break and there needs to be clarification of a rule, i.e. a question needs to be asked. By all means help the question along and take into account the age of the captain approaching you, but ideally we are here to educate our players so be patient. When in doubt always refer back to the rules.

**Game Management** is the focus for this week. Many umpires whilst very competent and have experience get very nervous when managing difficult or frustrated players. The protocol is as follows:

- **Page 62 of the Rules book** : Please check the book for the appropriate hand signals; once you are familiar with the protocol, controlling "chatty" on-court players becomes a little less daunting.

- Warnings, Suspensions and Ordering Off must be noted on the score sheet at the end of an interval or at the end of the game, please ensure the correct player & position is noted. BHSNA has recently changed its policy with stricter

penalties now applied, especially for repeat offenders; abuse of an umpire or any other player is not tolerated at BHSNA.
