Finals Information – For Coaches and Managers


Please see below about rules and regulations for Finals.

Please remind your sideline before and again on the day there is a zero tolerance for directing play, critical, negative comments and any offending spectators will be asked to leave the sideline.

Every team must make sure you have organised a Scorer, Carer and Timekeeper for the day as these need to stand on the side of the court along with the Coach and Manager.

- The carer is the only person that may step onto the court in the case of injury.
- The timekeeper along with the opposition timekeeper must stand together and record the length of time for all play stoppages throughout the game (you can use your phone). This time will be added on at the completion of the 4th quarter. Please make sure all players know that if play has stopped at any time during the game that they are to ignore the 4th quarter buzzer and continue to play listen to the umpires for when the game is finished. If by the end of the 3rd quarter you know extra time will be required, please organise someone to go to the admin building to notify the officials that extra time is required for your game, they will ask the amount of time and the court number. If there was only play stoppages in the 4th quarter, someone must go straight to the admin building to let them know. An official timekeeper will come to officiate the extra time at the end of the game.

Please see the below map of which side for each court is deemed for the officials (the red line shows where officials stand). All spectators must stand on the opposite side of the court.



- In semi-finals and finals games, If the game is a draw, ADMIN must be advised immediately.
- Substitutions and/or team changes are permitted during the interval and teams change ends.
- Extra time shall consist of 2 equal halves with an interval.
- If the game is still a draw when the second half is completed, play continues until 1 team gains a 2-goal margin.
- In Grand Finals for all ages, if the score is even at full time, both teams are declared Joint Winners.

Coaches/Co-ordinators - Different borrowing rules apply for finals - please read below information and if you have any questions please ask.

All Borrowed players need to be approved by BHSNA prior to Saturday, if you need to borrow please advise Leanne Scowen by 2pm Friday, you will also require the borrowed players team sheet. Any approved borrowed player will be written and stamped

by BHSNA on the scoresheet prior to the game. Please make sure the opposition has any borrowed players approved by BHSNA, these cannot be added to the scoresheet the day of the game.

- 1. Players may only participate in ONE Semi Final game, ONE Final Game and ONE Grand Final game per day.
- 2. In the event of a team being unable to field 7 of its registered players in a Finals game a player may be borrowed, in accordance with the normal borrowing guidelines, from a lower age, grade or division which has not reached Finals, players in teams who have been eliminated in Semi or Finals games ARE eligible to be borrowed to play in Grand Finals.
- 3. If 7 players of the playing team are available, a borrowed player may only play if a team member is injured or becomes ill. If an injured or sick player is able to resume playing then the borrowed player must leave the court.
- 4. If an ineligible player participates in any game in the Semi Finals, Finals or Grand Finals, that player is prohibited from participating in any subsequent games in that Competition. The team using this ineligible player forfeits the match in which this infringement occurred.
- 5. Forfeits (less than 5 players to take the court) for all Semi Finals, Finals and Grand Final games must be reported to Leanne Scowen who will notify BHSNA Registrar no later than <u>5.00 pm</u> on the Wednesday prior to the scheduled game.

Semi Finals Information - For Umpires

Please see a message from the BHSNA Umpires Committee & those umpires allocated a game in this year's Semi Finals. Should you have any issues at all with your allocations please let me know so we can arrange a swap.

This is Rachel's first Semi's game - Congratulations Rachel on being selected. The committee only selected a few GOLD's this year as we had such a large National C pool to choose from. I do appreciate all of those umpires who did submit their availability but may not have been selected. We hope to see you all back next season.

"... All care has been taken to ensure umpires are allocated when they have indicated their availability. Every game is of the highest importance to the players, no matter what grade they happen to play. A 10D game has been given the same amount of time and care when the umpiring committee have allocated umpires as an A1 game. We want all semi-finals [especially for those who may be involved in their first or last semi-final] to be one that they enjoy.

Umpires will be told their court number and grade as they are marked off. We will start marking off umpires 45 minutes prior to the start of their timeslot. Umpires cannot mark off for later timeslots.

We want to promote TEAM WHITE as a team, and to this end we want umpires to wait until their CO-UMPIRE has marked off and proceed to their COURT TOGETHER and undertake the pre-game checks starting with the space around the court.

As umpires you are entitled to 0.5m clear space along the side lines and 2m space behind the goal lines. You should politely request your spectators to move so that you are SAFE when umpiring and there is SPACE for players to take a THROW IN.

Umpires are quite busy before the game, checking goal post padding, making sure the court is free of debris, ball inflation is OK even before you get to the players to check them for jewellery, adornments and fingernail length. This is why we need you to mark off early. You have a duty of care to yourself and the players you are umpiring that all is as safe as it can be.

Reserve umpires are to arrive no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the game and be marked off. They are then seated near umpires' control until the first interval when they are released from their reserve duty. However, we do expect our reserve umpires to remain at the ground in case an umpire is injured after ¼ time and we call for one of the reserves to replace them. Reserves are important so please ensure your umpires are made aware of this...

Notes

- 1) Umpires to wear WHITES (incl. under garments)
- 2) Umpires may sign on 45 min prior to each time slot, not earlier
- 3) Umpires should wait until co-umpire signs on and go to their court together.
