Team White update

"Umpiring is a volunteer service – a fact frequently overlooked or taken for granted by players and spectators, who readily criticise the umpire for decisions and rarely offer praise. The importance of umpiring upon the maintenance of a good standard of play can never be stressed too strongly. However outstanding the players, however effective the coaching, in the long run it is the efficiency of the umpiring which influences the standard of play. Even lower standard teams with little or no coaching can improve with consistently good umpiring. An umpire is an integral part of the game and can make or mar a game. The enjoyment of the games depends on the efficiency and manner of the umpire."

At Oakhill Drive Netball Club we have a zero tolerance for any players, bench officials or spectators, who might ridicule or intimidate an umpire. Umpires are volunteers with a huge task - we ask that all spectators keep this in mind when an Umpire may have "missed" an infringement.

Whilst the 2020 season may only have 11 rounds, Oakhill still have 25 games to cover each week - 5 on Friday nights for our NetSetGO teams, and 20 games on the Saturday, that's a total of 275 games across the season that needed to be covered.

In addition to ensuring we have a suitably skilled umpire assigned to each game, we were also determined to keep some form of a development program running to increase the team.

Each developing umpire requires a Mentor/ Coach to work. We are fortunate at Oakhill to have dedicated & enthusiastic mentors to help on our program. A big shout out to our primary mentors this season: Kati H, Kim D, Kiri B & Zoe N.
