Summer netball anyone?


A number of our teams have already registered for the 21/22 Summer Comp at The Centre, Dural. This is a great way to keep your skills and fitness in check and have fun!

Netball NSW - Coaching development

On Monday 16 August the new registration and competition management system PlayHQ went live for Netball NSW. PlayHQ will replace MyNetball in 2022 and this is the first step as a number of Associations now start a pilot phase.

All Associations and Clubs will have the opportunity to undertake training on the new system in the next couple of months, enabling everyone to be ready to go live in 2022. All coaches need to ensure they have completed any online learning modules in My Netball by the end of August.
